

INFORMATION CLAUSE FOR THE PERSON SUBMITTING A REPORT

In accordance with Article 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"), we inform you that:

- 1. The Controller of the personal data provided in the "DSA" form and any data provided in connection with the submission is InsERT S.A., ul. Jerzmanowska 2, 54-519 Wrocław, Poland (hereinafter referred to as: Controller).
- 2. Compliance with data protection rules is supervised by the Data Protection Officer appointed by the Controller, who can be contacted via an email sent to iod@insert.com.pl.
- 3. Personal data will be processed for the following purposes:
 - 3.1. Fulfilling obligations arising from legal regulations—the legal basis for data processing is a legal obligation (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR in connection with Article 16 of the Digital Services Act/DSA);
 - 3.2. Archival (evidential) purposes related to the legitimate interest of InsERT S.A. concerning the safeguarding of information in the event of a legal need to prove facts—the legal basis for data processing is the legitimate interest of InsERT S.A. (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).
- 4. Your personal data will be processed for the duration of the report handling process, and after its completion, for the period necessary to fulfill reporting obligations or other rights arising from legal provisions, including at least 6 months from the decision to moderate disputed content based on Article 20 DSA. Processing will be carried out for a maximum of 1 (one) year after the completion of the report handling process.
- 5. In connection with the processing of personal data, you have the following rights:
 - 5.1. The right to access the data, the right to rectify data, the right to erase data, the right to restrict the processing of data, the right to data portability, the right to object to data processing,
 - 5.2. The right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (President of the Personal Data Protection Office) if you believe that the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.
- 6. Providing data in fields marked with an asterisk in the form is necessary to send a message via the form, except for reports related to information about sexual misconduct, sexual exploitation, child pornography, or solicitation for sexual purposes.
- 7. The provided personal data will not be used for automated decision-making, including profiling, as defined by GDPR regulations.
